The 3D Commitment to your Privacy

Our Privacy Policy was developed as an extension of our Respect Policy. Our Respect Policy is the highest standard that our company holds, and it ultimately governs all decisions we make.

Our goal is to combine the highest-quality products and services with the highest level of integrity and respect in dealing with our customers. The 3D Privacy Policy is designed to assist you in understanding how we collect, use and safeguard the personal information you provide to us and to assist you in making informed decisions when using our site, our products and services. This statement will be continuously assessed against new technologies, business practices and our customers' needs.

What Information Do We Collect?

When you visit our Web site you may provide us with two types of information: personal information you knowingly choose to disclose that is collected on an individual basis and Web site use information collected on an aggregate basis as you and others browse our Web site.

The personal information will be evident, because you will enter it into fields on our website: personal, credit card, and physician contact information.

Our website has a standard program embedded into the software that allows us to go back and look at what happens when people visit our website. The reason we use this software is to identify and fix any issues that may be a challenge for people on our website.

1. Personal Information You Choose to Provide

Credit Card Information

If you choose to purchase products or services from us or our partners, you may need to give personal information and authorization to obtain information from various credit services. For example, you may need to provide the following information:

- Name
- Mailing address
- Email address
- Credit card number
- Home and business phone numbers

Email Information

If you choose to correspond with us through email, we may retain the content of your email messages together with your email address and our responses. We provide the same protections for these electronic communications that we employ in the maintenance of information received by mail and telephone.

3D Medical will use your e-mail to full discharge our responsibilities to you for diligent customer service.

Physician Contact Information

If you choose to use RxAssist, you will provide us with physician contact information to pursue a device prescription on behalf of the patient.

Your patient contact and physician contact information will be used with the customers permission, for the purpose of securely faxing a prescription request to the patients physician using a HIPAA compliant, SSL Secured faxing service, MyFax.com.

Sharing Information with Strategic Partners

We may enter into strategic marketing alliances or partnerships with third parties who may be given access to aggregate information about our customers in general. **At no time** will personal information such as your name, address, telephone number and email be disclosed to anyone. In connection with strategic marketing alliances or partnerships, we will retain all ownership rights to the information, and we will not share information regarding your social security number or other personal financial data.

Notice of New Services and Changes

Occasionally, we may also use the information we collect to notify you about important changes to our Web site, new services and special offers we think you will find valuable. As our client, you will be given the opportunity to notify us of your desire not to receive these offers by clicking on a response box when you receive such an offer or by sending us an email request at customerservice@aeronebgo.com

How Do We Secure Information Transmissions?

When you send confidential personal credit card information to us on our Web site, a secure server software which we have licensed encrypts all information you input before it is sent to us. The information is scrambled en route and decoded once it reaches our Web site.

Other email that you may send to us may not be secure unless we advise you that security measures will be in place prior to your transmitting the information. For that reason, we ask that you do not send confidential information such as Social Security or account numbers to us through an unsecured email.

How Do We Protect Your Information?

Information Security.

We utilize encryption/security software to safeguard the confidentiality of personal information

we collect from unauthorized access or disclosure and accidental loss, alteration or destruction.

Evaluation of Information Protection Practices.

Periodically, our operations and business practices are reviewed for compliance with corporate policies and procedures governing the security, confidentiality and quality of our information.

Employee Access, Training and Expectations.

Our corporate values, ethical standards, policies and practices are committed to the protection of customer information. In general, our business practices limit employee access to confidential information, and limit the use and disclosure of such information to authorized persons, processes and transactions.

How Can You Access and Correct Your Information?

You may request access to all your personally identifiable information that we collect online and maintain in our database by emailing customerservice@aeronebgo.com.

Do We Disclose Information to Outside Parties?

We may provide aggregate information about our customers, sales, Web site traffic patterns and related Web site information to our affiliates or reputable third parties, but this information will not include personally identifying data, except as otherwise provided in this Privacy Policy.

What About Legally Compelled Disclosure of Information?

We may disclose information when legally compelled to do so, in other words, when we, in good faith, believe that the law requires it or for the protection of our legal rights.

In this event, 3D Medical will send an informational email to describe the situation, and how it was resolved.

What About Other Web Sites and Blogs Linked to Our Web Site?

Part of the 3D commitment to is to provide our customers with current and relevant information. To achieve this end, we try to link our site to other websites and blogs that we believe might be of interest. While we will make every attempt to effectively screen the web pages and blogs, there might be a situation where content on a linked site is dated, inaccurate, or offensive.

Secure Transfer of Information

All information gathered and transferred on aeronebgo.com is secure, so you can shop online in confidence. Aeronebgo.com uses a 128-bit SSL (Secure Socket Layer) encryption on all pages collecting private information (i.e. credit card data, email addresses, etc).
